Respected Sir,

Subject: Imploration to form alliance between INDIA and Vanchit Bahujan Aghadi (VBA).

Our recent Survey carried out for more than 2 months to know the **expectations of SC, ST, OBC people (Bahujan Samaj) of Maharashtra** from the political parties in the ensuing 2024 Lok Sabha and Vidhan Sabha Elections in Maharashtra indicates that:

- > 63 % participants desire an alliance between VBA and INDIA.
- > 49 % would prefer VBA in case of no alliance between VBA and INDIA.
- > 31% would prefer INDIA in case of no alliance between VBA and INDIA.
- > 9% would prefer BSP in case of no alliance between BSP and INDIA.
- ➤ 1% would prefer RPI (A) in case of no alliance between RPI(A) and INDIA.

Sir, the survey shows great potential of INDIA capturing 80% votes of Maharashtra's Bahujan Samaj. However, neither VBA nor INDIA is likely to get majority votes in Maharashtra, if they go separately. A copy of PR dated 29 March 2024 about the survey results is enclosed.

We could intimate the survey results to respected Shri Prakash Ambedkarsaheb, President, VBA little later than the day of declaration of first list of VBA's candidates, since the Survey's analysis could be completed after his action.

We, as the social activists are primarily concerned about the progress of the Bahujan Samaj and feel that in the present scenario, only an alliance between INDIA and VBA in Maharashtra can win INDIA, which we feel, besides promoting constitutional values, would strive for educational, social, economic, political and cultural development of the depressed classes. We, therefore, wish such alliance between INDIA and VBA.

We therefore implore your good offices WITH FOLDED HANDS to assume the role of an elder brother and successfully conclude the alliance with VBA to win INDIA to realize the prosperity of the Bahujan Samaj, thereby.
